English

As writers we will write in a range of styles: reports, diary entries, explanations with the main focus being story writing. We will use our class reader (as well as other texts) as a stimulus for writing. Focussed spelling work will continue every week in school.

Each child will continue with their individual reading book and we will also read collectively in school. We will cover comprehension activities and aim to improve our vocabulary and reading skills.



Maths

As mathematicians we will be focussing on place value and working on efficient written methods for all 4 operations. We will continue to use Times Tables Rockstars to improve our speed and fluency with times tables. My maths Homework will continue to be set as homework to reinforce concepts taught in school.

Science



Our topic this term is all about forces around us. As scientists we will use magnets and observe how they repel and attract; we will investigate magnetism with different metals. We will discover more about Sir Isaac Newton and use Newton meters. We will continue to ask questions, investigate, record and evaluate.
