Welcome back! I hope you have enjoyed the break and the children are keen to get stuck into the Summer Term as much as we are. Alongside our curriculum topic (Castles and Fairytales), we hope to be outside as much as possible exploring growth and changes on Welly Walk and in our garden.

### **Curriculum information:**

**English:** Year 1s and 2s will begin to have spellings once more. The spelling tests will be on a Monday and new spellings given out every Tuesday. Please encourage your child/ren to actively practise a ***little every day*** for a test the following week. It is really important that the children come prepared for this and that ALL children engage with this at home. There will be 3 groups – A, B and C. Your child will come home with the termly spelling grid with their groups focus spellings.

Reading is an essential skill that the children should consolidate through reading at home ***every day***. Please complete the home school reading record book for us so we can reward your child's effort. If your child is reading other books outside of their school books please tell us about this too; it's great to hear about this and will help your child to build a love for reading.

Our writing this term will focus on traditional tales and story writing.

### **Maths:**

Year 1 and 2 - Please continue to help your child to learn their times tables. Class 1) focuses on the following tables 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s.

Reception - To support Reception children continue to develop counting skills to at least 50 and practise recognising numbers 0-20.

**Our Christian Value** this term will focus on the theme of Compassion and Thankfulness. Look out for the Home School Values Sheet coming home soon for more details of activities to explore together.

**PE** will be on Monday with Miss Coombes and Thursdays with Mrs Lambert each week. Please ensure your child/ren have their **kits in school all week**.

**Welly Walk** ensure your child has their welly walk kits at school every day.

It is beginning to heat up so please ensure you apply sun cream before school and your child has a named hat.
