### **KS2 Curriculum information:**

Reading is an essential skill that the children should consolidate through reading at home ***every day***. Please complete the home school reading record book for us so we can reward your child's effort.

**Maths:** Please continue to help your child to learn their times tables through using Times Tables Rockstars. These are an essential skill used in many aspects of maths and lack of fluency in this area can seriously hinder your child's progress. Our first maths topic will be place value and a revision of the four operations. My Maths Homework will be continued to be set and your child is expected to complete the tasks set. Tasks will always reinforce the learning taking place in class. Please support your child with this so that they make good progress.

**Our Christian Value** this term will focus on the theme of **forgiveness**. Look out for the Home School Values Sheet coming home soon for more details of activities to explore together.

**Our PE** will be Monday and Thursday afternoons. Please ensure your child/ren have their kits in school. PE is part of the National Curriculum. It would be a good idea to have joggers and sweatshirts as PE will be outside and we are going into autumn and winter.
